

PACE OF PLAY

Minimize your practice swings

Be ready to hit when it is your turn

Proceed to your ball as soon as it is safe to do so

Take your practice swings in advance of your turn to hit the ball

“Hit out of turn” if it is safe to do so

Study the line of your putt while other are putting

Mark your score after arriving at net tee box

If there is a hole open in front of you, you are playing too slow

Lay your clubs on the way to exit to your golf cart

Continuous putting especially a very short putt (marking takes extra time)

First player to putt out stand by flag to place back in hole

Putt while waiting for a player to drive there cart up to green

If falling behind 2 players go ahead and tee off next hole

Drop a player at their ball and you go hit if opposite sides and safe to hit

Keep head covers off (driver) on the clubs you frequently use

Put head covers back on at the next hole

Do not look for a lost ball longer than 5 minutes

Use travel time to your ball to plan your next shot

Take a couple clubs with you when you walk from the cart to your ball

Carry extra ball should you find yourself needing one for a lost ball

If there is a chance of lost ball, immediately hit a provisional ball
