This continuity and stability will be important as we work our way through the golf course irrigation and bunker renovation project over the next several years.

FINANCIALS

The operating results (subject to audit) for the full year 2023 are complete. The net result is an excess of \$133,284 versus a budgeted excess of \$20,727. We have higher revenue due to the higher return on our investments and irrigation rebates from the City of Aurora. We also have lower expenses in communal water, landscape services and snow removal expenses. For full year ending December 2023 reserve net income shows a deficiency of \$1,573 vs budgeted deficiency of \$9,478.

Approximately 50 Homeowners were present at the January 16th Quarterly Membership meeting. These meetings are the best way to learn and comment on the direction of Traditions. The minutes are available on the heritageeaglebend.com website. We urge you to attend the next meeting on April 16th.

Our snow push program takes approximately ten hours to complete, and the goal is to start two hours after it stops snowing. Updates on the push are posted on the snow line (303-343-3063) as to the status of the push. We know that the timing may not be convenient for you, but it is a big project to clean all driveways and porches. Many residents scoop their own driveways and deserve special recognition.

Here it is March already, which means we begin to get busier and busier with all of the activity planned for 2024. We ended 2023 significantly in the black, so the board prior to the end of year moved \$40,000 into the reserve account. The significant savings was based on the very wet spring and our change in landscaping companies.

We still have 8 buildings that need new roofs and this year we plan on doing 3 roofs. We also will be painting the Biloxi/Buchanan/Kettle homes. The painting project will begin on May 6th and will take approximately 10 weeks, weather permitting. The contractor will start at Biloxi/ Buchanan and work up Biloxi then over through Kettle.

Detailed information was sent to each homeowner in this area, on how to prepare for painting and how to make color changes. If you live in this area and did not receive an email, please notify the hotline. If you want to change colors or trim colors you need to get the paperwork signed quickly.

2024 HEBGC Master Board Election

Beginning with the 2012 HEBGC MBOD election, our association has used an electronic voting system provided by Vote-Now. Simply put, it reduces the expenses associated with preparing and mailing traditional paper ballots and streamlines the election process, including the vote count.

The official 2024 Election Day is Friday, April 12th.

All votes must be cast online or received as postal mail at Vote-Now's office by 12 Noon (Mountain Daylight time). There are three(3) – three(3) year term vacancies for the HEBGC Master Board.

An eligible voter must be a resident and on the Warranty Deed or part of a Family Trust etc. The voter's HOA account must be in good standing and must be current as of Friday, March 22, 2024. An account is considered in good standing when there are no past due HOA fees, special assessments, or fines imposed by the HOA.

Eligible voters who do not have internet access at their residence can vote using the Clubhouse computer, computers at a public library, ask a neighbor or call the Admin Office with your special code, and we can cast your vote for you. Voters who cannot or do not wish to use the electronic system can request a paper ballot mailed to their address on record.

Online voters receive an e-mail invitation in their designated e-mail account. **If your email address has changed since January 2024, please contact the Admin Office at 720-235-1888 or email Jillian at JWyatt@heritageeaglebend.com to update it right away.** The invitation includes a link to www.vote-now.com's secure site with an embedded personal registration code. Once a ballot has been cast using this code, it cannot be re-used. When the link is clicked, the ballot automatically loads in a browser window. Clicking a candidate's name will show her/his biography. A verification screen shows the candidates chosen and an alert about any races in which no votes were cast. Voters can return to the ballot to make changes if necessary and submit their vote. A Vote-Now staff member acts as election administrator.

Paper ballots will be mailed by Vote-Now to voters who have not registered to vote electronically or those that don't have an email address on file with us. These voters will be required to send their ballots to Vote-Now via postal mail at their own expense. A message is included in the directions on the paper ballot specifying that if a ballot is cast electronically, the paper ballot will not be counted if it is mailed. When the paper ballots are received by Vote-Now, the election administrator will enter the voter's security code from the paper ballot and casts the vote by entering the code into the Vote-Now computer. The tallies are automatically made by the software, combining both paper and electronic votes. If the security code has already been used by the voter, the administrator will be notified and the voter will not be able to cast a vote a second time.
