President's Message by Rex Gambrell, President of Master Board

he Golf course irrigation, bunkers and tees project is moving forward as planned. We have a Letter of Intent signed with our contractor, Landscapes

Unlimited, and will be signing the contract with them soon.

Just so you know our Irrigation System in its current state is leaking 10,000-30,000 gallons of water per day due to leaks underground. This puts extra strain on the pump station with constant cycling of our pump in order to keep the irrigation lines pressurized. Most of the leaks are from PVC pipe (polyvinyl chloride) joints where glue has failed after being installed 25 years ago. The new system will be HDPE pipe (high density polyethylene pipe) rather than PVC. All joints will be fused, not glued. The pipe should last 100 years in the ground.

A new Toro Irrigation system will be installed, that will replace our current Rainbird irrigation system. Having Toro Infinity heads installed will allow our techs to repair heads without having to dig them up to replace them. Two new Watertronics pump stations will be installed that will allow for 24/7 monitoring of the irrigation system on cell phones and computers. Watertronics is the premier pump manufacturing company in the golf business which will include round-the-clock support from their headquarters.

The bunkers will be reshaped for easier access for golfers in our community. A new Billy Bunker Drainage system will be installed in all existing or new bunkers. All bunkers will have a two-inch gravel layer applied over the bunker floor and a herringbone tile

system. The gravel is sprayed with a polymer to lock it in place so that the gravel will serve as a conduit for water to transfer down the bunker floor slopes into the tile pipe system, thus reducing or eliminating sand movement. The polymer liner secures the gravel blanket and prevents native soils underneath from growing into the bunkers and contaminating the sand that was installed overtop the liner. According to our golf course architect's plan, some bunkers will be moved due to changes in golf equipment technology and how the game is played along with how a bunker shapes a hole. Additionally, there will be several bunkers removed due to non-use.

The native conversion seeding outside of the gates is complete and germination is ongoing. The native conversion that covers approximately four acres has saved HEB at least \$500,000 in new irrigation installation cost. Additionally, estimates indicate yearly savings of 10 million gallons of water and a total of 50,000 annual expense dollars for water, mowing, fertilization and chemical costs in these areas.

As I have mentioned in prior meetings a portion of the work is scheduled to begin this summer or fall that includes the construction of the pump house on hole 11. This work will not affect golf play.

In the spring of 2026, the main line irrigation pipe will be installed outside of the fairways and rough in native areas of the golf course. The installation of this pipe should also not affect play.

In the fall of 2026 nine holes at a time will be closed so that lateral lines, sprinkler heads, bunker work & new forward tees can be installed.

The projected completion of all golf course work is the end of 2026 or early 2027.

To prevent this in the future the board is exploring having SaBell's provide "Winter Watering" services as needed. We also must decide the best way to address the existing dry/dead grass conditions. Stay tuned!!

IRRIGATION

The new controllers that were installed at the end of last year will bring new efficiency to our Communal System. They read the watering needs of each area and run accordingly. In the past the older controllers were set manually to run at specified times each week. Now, they run at different times determined by the system. This will achieve the requirements that the Water Department has imposed on water usage.



here will not be a Genealogy Club meeting in July or August as we are off for the summer. We will return in September.

Last month I talked about libraries and the value of using them as a resource when you are doing research. I want to continue that theme because there are more than just local and internet libraries. There are also university libraries (try the university in the home state of your ancestor. They might have donated papers or be mentioned in someone else's papers). Large genealogical societies' libraries usually have material from all over the world. (Denver is one of those libraries as is the Allen County Public Library Genealogy Center https://www.acpl.lib.in.us/ and, not to be forgotten, international libraries in the country/city/county where your ancestors lived prior to immigrating to the U.S. One fantastic resource is the National Library of Ireland at https://www.nli.ie/.

There are also digital libraries that contain a wealth of information. The Library of Congress (LOC), https://www.loc.gov/collections/, is free and has maps from all over the U.S. Their Chronicling America newspaper collection has newspapers from all over the country. David Rumsey's Historical Map Collection at https://www.davidrumsey.com/ has a wealth of maps that can help with your research.

There are so many resources that are not contained within FamilySearch or Ancestry with new ones popping up all the time.
