President's Message

Landscapes Unlimited our golf course irrigation, bunkers and tees contractor continues to stay on schedule for completion of this massive project. Main line irrigation pipe has been installed on all eighteen holes of the golf course. Now that completion of the installation of main line irrigation pipe has taken place preparation for installing lateral lines for irrigation heads along with bunker and forward tee work throughout the golf course is next. The actual installation on the golf course of lateral lines and irrigation heads in addition to bunker work will start in September after the Labor Day weekend. At that point 9 holes will be closed starting with holes 1 through 9. The pump located on hole 11 has been installed. The pumphouse building that covers the pump will be constructed and then completed very soon.



I wanted to also mention that due to the City of Aurora's water restrictions golf foursomes are now limited to two carts per that foursome. Hopefully this will help minimize turf stress and preserve course conditions as much as possible. Due to the City of Aurora's current water restrictions, we are not receiving raw water from the city of Aurora for golf course irrigating this year like in past years. All of the water that you see being put onto the golf course and in common areas is coming from the Eagle Bend Metro District two wells. So, this year in the hottest months of the summer we will receive approximately 50 to 60% of the water that we have received in prior years. Consequently, the condition of the golf course along with pocket parks and common areas throughout the community will most likely suffer this year as the summer progresses.

FINANCIALS

The operating results (subject to audit) for May 2026 are complete. The net result is an overrun of Net Income of \$143,716 versus a budgeted overrun of \$12,879. This large Net Income overrun is due to the Snow Push expenses being trued up in May. As you can imagine, there was a large underrun in snow push expense for 2026. These savings should remain for the rest of the year. However, with the City of Aurora being in a water restriction mode, we will monitor the water expenses throughout the summer. We are hopeful that we will not have to use any of the snow push savings for any water expenses.

The reserve results for May are complete as well. The net result is an overrun of \$68,801 versus a budgeted overrun of \$107,830. We will be receiving some large invoices for Roofs, Gutters and Painting that will be paid out over the next month. Overall, we do not see any issues with these expenses.

IRRIGATION

We are closely monitoring communal lawn irrigation water use throughout Traditions HOA and managing water use to be compliant with our City of Aurora water usage allotment. Exceeding the city water allotment comes with a significant cost that would affect the Traditions HOA budget (eventually leading to HOA fee increases). Consequently, the Traditions board will assure that we stay within city water use targets. This may cause lawns in some areas to become less green.

LANDSCAPING

The Traditions HOA board is evaluating our existing landscape service provider and comparing alternatives for an upcoming contract renewal. Our goal is to continue lawn care and snow removal in a way that complement our community and reflects the pride that we all have as owners.

In the meantime, we are working with our contractor to come up with future improvement projects, and we are setting aside money to pay for the improvements. Once the drought situation changes, we will be ready to take on these projects. Until then we ask for your patience.

PARKING REMINDERS FOR HERITAGE EAGLE BEND RESIDENTS

No Overnight Street Parking

Overnight parking on streets is not allowed anywhere in Heritage Eagle Bend. The only exception is a 48-hour period for RV or moving truck loading/unloading. Moving a vehicle temporarily and returning it to the street may be viewed as an attempt to bypass the rules.

8-Hour Parking Limit

A vehicle may **not** be parked for more than 8 hours in any 7-day period on streets, frontage roads, or common driveways.

Guest Parking Is for Guests

Guest parking areas are located throughout the community and are intended for short-term guest use only. They are **not** to be used by residents for long-term parking or as a way to avoid using their driveway.

Driveway Parking Rules

- Permitted: Single Family Homes and Traditions Homes
- Prohibited: The Villages — even if it seems you're not blocking anyone, driveway parking is not allowed in the shared driveways.

Temporary Overflow Parking

Short-term parking is available at the **Clubhouse** for residents with special circumstances. A Permit is required and is available from the Welcome Desk or Administrative Office.

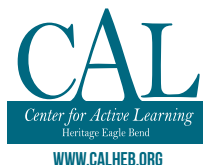

HEBGC Genealogy Club News!! by Mary DeHay

Many years ago I started researching my own and my husband Bill's family histories using two different family tree files stored on a 1980s IBM home computer database called Roots III.



In the 1990s I wanted to join the Mayflower Descendants' Society and to do so, I had to provide birth, marriage, and death data from approved sources to document my descent from passenger Stephen Hopkins. In so doing, I noticed that some of the names I found were familiar, but they were not my ancestors. They were Bill's! It turned out that he was descended from Stephen Hopkins too! On my side, there were ten generations between me and Hopkins, and on Bill's there were twelve. Bill and I are ninth cousins twice removed. We are living proof of Pedigree Collapse (discussed in the July magazine)! Later I was able to merge Bill's and my family trees into one large tree with many more shared ancestors.

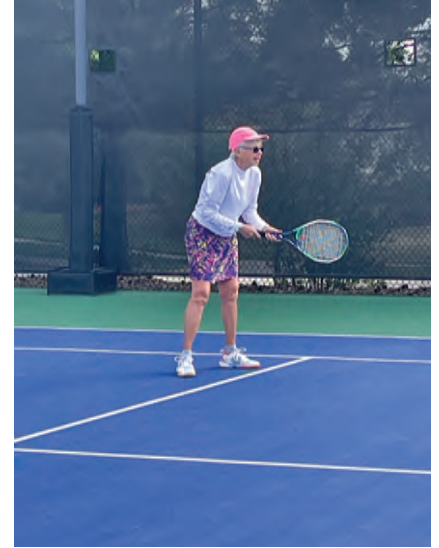
Tennis Club *by David Peck*

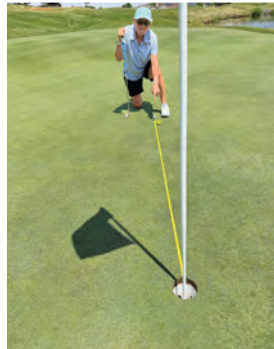

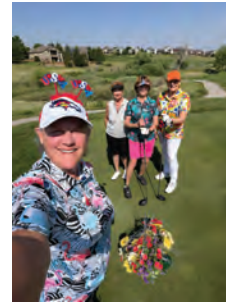

We would also like to express our sincere appreciation for the support of the HEBGC Districts through our District Challenge—an idea that the District Delegates enthusiastically embraced and made their own. Together, the districts raised an incredible \$13,480. Every district raised enough money to sponsor a hole, game hole, hole-in-one hole, or a military hero. In total, 16 holes were represented by HEBGC Districts. Each district's hole sign was customized to identify and honor the military heroes (past and present) they selected.

So, which district raised the most money? District 32! Thank you for your outstanding support. A commemorative plaque, created by Corey Swift, will be displayed in the golf shop trophy case to recognize the winning districts. It begins with Districts 9 & 10, whose outstanding support in 2025 inspired what officially became the District Challenge in 2026.

The golf event sold out five weeks before the tournament, filling the field with 144 players. A portion of each player's registration fee contributed additional funds to the fundraiser.
