The installation of the main line irrigation pipe throughout the golf course is for the most part complete. Landscapes Unlimited has been working on wrapping up a few items with that installation phase of the project. Preparation for installation of irrigation heads and lateral lines along with bunker and forward tee work has been ongoing throughout the month of August.

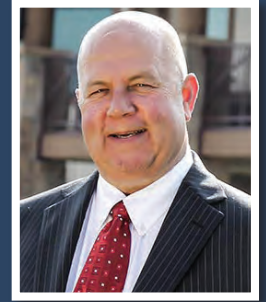
As you know the lateral lines, bunkers and forward tee work will start in September after the Labor Day weekend. As I have mentioned many times before 9 holes will be closed the Tuesday after Labor Day starting with holes 1 through 9 so work can begin. The pump house building on hole 11 has been completed.

I wanted to also mention that throughout the Aurora and Denver metro areas several golf courses conditions are suffering due to the mandatory Stage 1 drought restrictions. In addition, the hot and dry summer conditions have been making things worse. Since water use on most of all of these courses has to be dramatically reduced, there are many areas that are dry and yellowing throughout these courses. Areas such as fairway edges, roughs, native grasses and non-play zones are receiving minimal to no water and seem to now be going dormant. For the most part that same thing is happening at our golf course, driving range and common areas so that irrigation watering can be focused on our fairway and greens area. In many areas turf areas are extremely dry and seemingly going dormant. However, I must say our golf course overall in many ways looks far superior to most any of the other golf courses in the Aurora and Denver metro areas. I believe that is attributed to our access to the water we receive from the Eagle Bend Metro District water wells. Additionally, Marty and his grounds staff are doing a fantastic job in maintaining and managing the golf course under these difficult circumstances and conditions.

September in Colorado means cooler mornings, football weekends, wondering whether today's weather calls for shorts or a jacket, and the annual debate over whether it's too early for pumpkin-spice everything! Whatever your opinion, I hope you enjoy the changing season and all that makes Traditions such a wonderful place to call home. Have a great September!

FINANCIALS

The operating results (subject to audit) for June 2026 are complete. The net result is an overrun of Net Income of \$137,336 versus a budgeted overrun of \$416. This large Net Income overrun is due to the Snow Push

expenses. As you can imagine, there was a large underrun in snow push expense for 2026. These savings should remain for the rest of the year. However, with the City of Aurora being in a water restriction mode, we will monitor the water expenses throughout the summer. We are hopeful that we will not have to use any of the snow push savings for any water expenses.

The reserve results for June are complete as well. The net result is an underrun of \$36,162 versus a budgeted underrun of \$182,444. We have received the expected large invoices for Roofs, Gutters and Painting which is causing this underrun. Overall, we do not see any issues with these expenses.

IRRIGATION

Our Director of Irrigation (Bob the Aquaman) continues to work closely with the City of Aurora on water utilization and the mandated water allocation assigned to each area of Traditions HOA communal watering zones. This effort is challenging as the City has been overwhelmed with petitions from across Aurora on historical water use and calculations of 2026 drought mandates. Currently lawns (on average) are looking green, but hot July and August impacts could further reduce our allowed watering.

Village Voice by Marie Welch

The Villages Landscape Committee is moving forward with plans to convert several of our existing tree-scape areas to xeriscaping. These improvements are intended to create attractive, more water-efficient landscape areas while helping reduce long-term water use and maintenance needs.

The Committee is currently working toward completing the **Algonquian and Biloxi/Buchanan areas** before winter weather and snowfall arrive. Residents may begin to see activity in these areas as preparations for the conversions get underway.

You may also notice some of the grass throughout the Villages beginning to fade or turn yellow in the coming weeks. Please don't be alarmed. We have reached our water allotment for the season and will need to make significant

reductions in irrigation during September. While the change in appearance may be noticeable, these cutbacks are necessary as we work to stay within our available water allocation.

Watch for Your Ballot

Villages homeowners should also be on the lookout for their upcoming ballots, which are expected to arrive in the mail by the **fourth week of September**. This year's ballot will include **three Board of Directors positions** as well as the **2027 Villages budget**.

Your participation is important, so please be sure to complete and return your ballot. If you need assistance returning your ballot or would like someone to pick it up, please contact the Villages hotline to make arrangements.

Thank you to all Villages residents for your continued participation and cooperation as we work together to maintain and improve our community.

FALL CLEAN UP!

As Fall approaches, here are some reminders!

Fall is upon us, and with the colder weather approaching, we know people are beginning to think about prepping their homes for the upcoming seasons. Below is some helpful information on commonly asked questions regarding the colder weather and keeping the exterior of your home neat and well maintained:

Exterior Storage – No storage is permitted on the exterior of the property. This includes lawn mowers, ladders, gardening tools etc. Empty pots must be rid of dead plants, as well stored out of site. Storage sheds and bins are also not permitted.

Leaf Clean-Up – Make sure to take a look at your yards once the trees shed their leaves, and be sure to rake and bag any fallen leaves. Please do not blow them into the streets.

Artificial Flowers – As much as we may start to miss our summer flowers, artificial flowers are not permitted and may not be used in the landscaping or exterior decorations of homes.

Tree Trimming Reminder

– If your trees in your Tree Lawn (area between sidewalk and street) have over-hanging branches on the sidewalks or streets, please be certain to have them trimmed at your earliest convenience.

Please note per City of Aurora, trees must be trimmed to a minimum height of 8 feet above sidewalks, and a minimum of 13.5 feet above streets.

As a reminder, **ALL** exterior improvements require advanced approval before starting any work. This includes but is not limited to paint, roofs, decks, awnings, railings, landscape, fountains, hot tubs, patios, concrete projects, and all fencing. 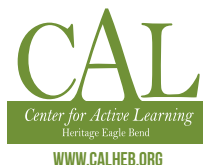

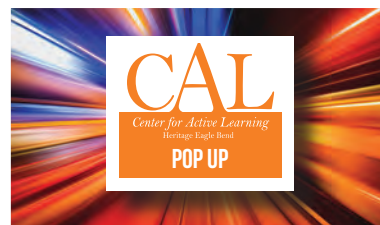

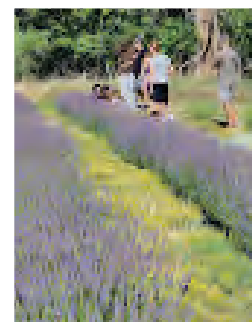


Our July meeting took place at the Pollywog Station Lavender Farm in Parker.
